APPENDIX TO 2020 WMYC AND DSC JOINT COVID NOTICE OF RACE & COVID SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Preamble

This appendix is aimed to bring back racing to the WMYC/DSC combined sailing where restrictions are in place through Government Covid Regulation. As such this may mean very late changes as regulation changes. It is the competitors responsibility to remain familiar with this appendix

1. RACING RULES

Races will be sailed under the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* , together with the RYA National Prescriptions, the 2020 West Mersea Yacht Club & Dabchicks Sailing Club Joint Notice of Race(covid) and Sailing Instructions(covid) and this Appendix, together with any subsequent amendments issued to those Sailing Instructions and this Appendix.

2. SERIES & ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Covid restriction Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions shall apply
- 2.2 The series will consist of 5 races.
- 2.3 All participants shall have completed a “Personal Location form” as provided on the WMYC website
- 2.5 Boats shall comply with the crew maximum of six under the 1+mitigation regulations. See Appendix A. Compliance within social distancing regulations is expected. Boats may not protest for breach of this instruction. Changes rule 63
- 2.6 This series will be scored using IRC Ratings

3. CLASS FLAGS

Numeral Pennant 1 class flag shall be flown from the backstay of yachts competing in all races in this Series. Sail numbers shall be clearly seen from at least the Mainsail

4. COURSES

The courses will be displayed on the Committee Boat before the preparatory signal for the race. The course may also be broadcast by the Committee Boat on VHF Channel 77.

6. DISCARDS ALLOWED

Regardless of the number of races sailed, the best 4 scores of each boat will be counted for the series





Appendix A

Crew Configurations

No competitor may have a crew number greater than six. As from 14th September 2020 this is an English legal requirement. The crew should be social distanced in accordance with 1+ mitigation

Failure to comply may lead to a legal report being made.
