France

Sauvignon Blanc, Alain Mecon,

The signature of Sauvignon is immediate, providing all the expected pleasure of this grape.

² Pinot Grigio, Cortefresca, Italy £18.95 £4.95 £6.45 Pinot Grigio needs little introduction. Perfect as an aperitif or to match with fish, chicken or seafood dishes.

3 Chardonnay, Auction House, Australia £18.95 £4.95 £6.45

A pure fruit driven Chardonnay without the clumsy application of oak.

4 Chenin Blanc, Cape Heights, Western Cape, South Africa £19.45

A well balanced and elegant dry white brimming with aromas of lemon and lime. Excellent with spicy dishes.

Sauvignon Blanc, Honu, Marlborough, New Zealand £26.95

'Kiwi' Sauvignon Blanc needs little introduction - perfect as an aperitif or to enjoy with a variety of cuisine.

24 Sauvignon Blanc, Mirror Lake, Marlborough, New Zealand £25.95 £6.75 £8.95

6 L'Ormarine 'Duc de Morny' Picpoul de Pinet, France £25.75

Located opposite the Bouzigues oyster beds near Beziers - a perfect match for fish and seafood dishes.

7 Macon-Charnay-les-Macon, 'les Piliers' Genetie, France £28.95

The Maconnais is a happy hunting ground for those wishing to enjoy classic Chardonnay without the premium of Burgundy's Côte d'Or.

Rosé Wines

8 Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy £18.95 £4.95 £6.45 Appealing colour with enticing fruit and a crisp dry style.

Grenache Rosé, Bruno Andreu, Languedoc, France £25.75

A delightfully dry yet fruity rosé making the best use of two southern French grape varieties. Careful winemaking creates a pale pink colour and masses of flavours to enjoy as an aperitif or to match food.

9 Chateau Deidiere Rosé, Côtes de Provence, France £26.95 £6.95 £9.25

Possibly the premier region for rosé wine in France - a perfect colour matched by elegant fruit. Perfect with seafood and grilled or baked fish dishes.

A four-year-old Port, made from grade A grapes, the finest grapes grown in the Douro.

11 Merlot, Arena Negra, Chile £17.95 £4.65 £6.15

Chile seems to be ticking all the boxes for the enthusiastic wine consumer, with the soft approachable Merlot leading the charge.

Borsao Garnacha Joven, Campo de Borja, Spain £18.95 £4.95 £6.45

Delightful rich red fruit flavours combine with supple tannins to create an easy drinking red.

Malbec, Para Dos, San Juan, Argentina £18.95 £4.95 £6.45

Malbec is currently the darling of the Argentine vineyard - perfect for all red meat options.

Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Artesa, £25.85 Spain

Rioja is perfect to match with a range of red meat dishes.

15 Chianti Riserva Roccialta, Uggiano, Italy £25.85

A young team of winemakers in a traditional estate have transformed Uggiano into a style to be savoured.

16 Château Haut Pasquet, Bordeaux, £25.85

A wonderful claret from the Dubourg family who consistently show the best elements of Bordeaux's Merlot and Cabernet grapes.

17 Wishbone, Magpie Estate, South Australia £25.85

A classic South Australian blend full of warm plum and raspberry fruit.

Pinot Noir, River Retreat, Trentham Estate, Australia £25.85 £6.75 £8.95

One of the jewels in the crown from Trentham Estate, showing off the potentional of Pinot Noir in Australia.

19 Di Maria Prosecco, Spumante, Italy £23.95 £7.45 Prosecco's popularity shows no signs of diminishing - perfect to meet and greet.

20 Crémant de Limoux, Les Graimenous £34.55

Decanter Magazine justifiably rated this gorgeous Cremant as one of the best alternatives to Champagne.

21 Etienne Lefevre Reserve, Brut Grand Cru Champagne, France £53.95

From a small family domaine based in the small village of Verzy. A blend of 25% Chardonnay and 75% Pinot Noir this is a delicious champagne to savour with family and friends.

22 Louis Roederer Brut, NV Champagne, £69.95

Founded in 1776, Champagne Louis Roederer is today one of the last major independent champagne houses. A careful blending of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier creates a complex wine with finesse and structure.
