Crew

A Crew member must be between 18 and 35 years of age and may benefit from this category until the age of 35. They must then apply for Associate or Full membership if they wish to remain members of the club. This category has specific restrictions in the use of the club facilities.

Cadet / Young Adult

A young person aged between the age of 8 and 17 years will qualify as a Cadet. On their 18th Birthday they must apply for Full, Associate or Crew membership if they wish to remain a member of the club. Those young people in full time education and who are between the ages of 18 and 25 may pay the Young Adult rate of subscription.

Long Service

Any serving member who reaches the age of 60 before the start of the subscription year, may pay the Long Service rate of subscription, provided that at that time the sum of their age and years of membership equals or exceeds 80 and they have been in continuous membership for at least 10 years.

Over 80

A serving member reaching the age of 80 before the start of the subscription year may pay the Over 80s rate of subscription, provided that at such time they have been in continuous membership for at least the previous 30 years.

Entrance Fee

Every person over 25 years, except those applying for Crew membership shall on election pay an entrance fee 40% of their relevant annual subscription fee.

New Members

New members' applications and any alteration to the existing membership must be approved by the General Committee. It is the General Committee that has the final say on the membership category allocated. Previous members rejoining the Club and members wishing to upgrade their membership category will not normally be charged an additional fee.

The above information is for guidance only and the Club Memorandum and Articles of Association and Byelaws are the authoritative text as regards any Membership matters. Attention in particular is drawn to House bye-law no.4 : Members may introduce guests as visitors to the Club premises. The number of visits an individual guest makes to the Club is limited to 6 per year, irrespective of which member introduces them.
